4) Detailed justification

<u>Requirement 1</u>: 8460 grants awarded for home batteries for private housing in Flanders since Q2 2021

Annex 1 provides a comprehensive list of all grants for home batteries submitted in 2021 and 2022 under the new optimized legislation for home battery grants. This legislation was officially approved on July 9, 2021, came into force on July 25, 2021, and retroactively applied to all grant applications from April 1, 2021, onwards [see: BE-C[C11]-R[R-101.S1]-M[1]).

Only private persons are eligible for the grant. The table provides a breakdown of premiums awarded to individuals by province. Based on the unique identifier, the beneficiary and exact location can be retrieved.

Due to the enormous success, the battery grant was cofinanced by own budgetary means.
